

Artificial Turf Maintenance Tips

Regular Cleaning

- **Remove debris:** Regularly clear leaves, twigs, and other debris using a leaf blower, rake, or stiff brush. This helps prevent organic matter from decomposing and damaging the turf.
- **Brush fibers:** Periodically brush the artificial turf fibers with a stiff brush to restore their upright position and enhance the turf's appearance.



Addressing Stains and Spills

- **Blot spills:** Immediately blot spills using a clean cloth or paper towel to help prevent staining. Rinse the area with water if needed.
- **Remove stains:** For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent mixed with water. Gently scrub the stained area with a soft brush, then rinse thoroughly.



Pet Waste Management

- **Solid waste:** Promptly remove solid pet waste from the turf using a plastic bag or scoop, then dispose of it properly in a trash receptacle.
- **Urine:** Rinse the affected area with water to dilute and remove odors. Consider using an artificial turf cleaner or pet-specific odor neutralizer if necessary.
