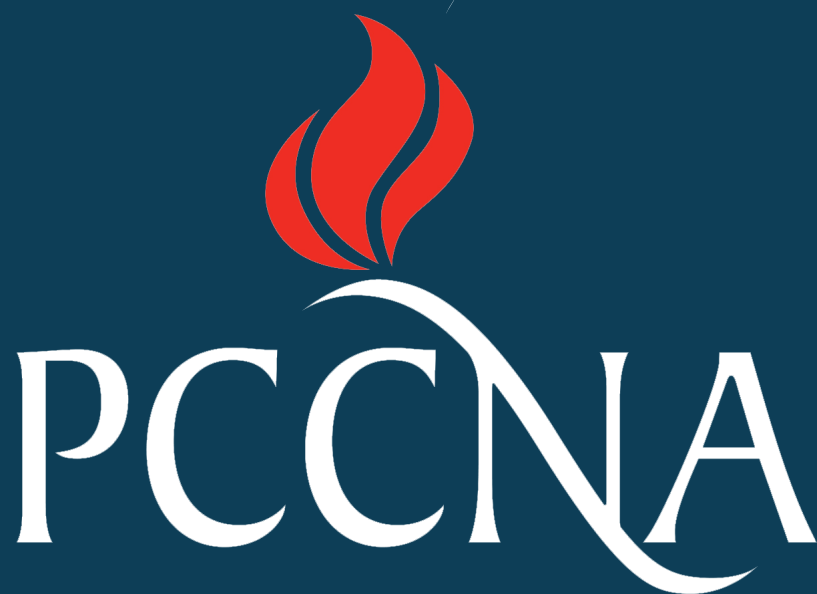

Since these churches and fellowships share a common history of Holy Spirit renewal and an overriding goal of evangelizing the world, they wish to join in a common witness to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all flesh in the last days.

The desire of the Pentecostal/Charismatic Churches of North America is to give expression to the inherent principles of spiritual unity and fellowship among Pentecostal believers, leaving inviolate the existing forms of government adopted by its members and recognizing that every freedom and privilege enjoyed by any group shall remain its undisturbed possession.

The Pentecostal/Charismatic Churches of North America are committed to the message of reconciliation through the cross and unity in the power of the Holy Spirit, which became a reality on the day of Pentecost and was demonstrated with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Azusa Street at the beginning of the twentieth century.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Embraced by PCCNA Members

We believe the Bible to be the inspired, only infallible, authoritative Word of God.

Ask yourself the question, "Why do I want our denomination, network, parachurch ministry, or church to join PCCNA?"

- PCCNA provides mutual worship, fellowship, dialogue, and networking.
- PCCNA provides authentic relationships and lasting friendships.
- PCCNA prioritizes racial reconciliation in the body of Christ.
- PCCNA limits membership to ministries in the U.S., Canada, and Mexico.
- PCCNA values demonstrating unity in acts of compassion and justice.
- PCCNA does not provide credentials.
- PCCNA does not provide "covering" or "accountability" as in the cases, for instance, of moral failure or church conflict.

Familiarize yourself with the "annual contribution" requirement. Funds are not required until membership is recommended by the executive committee and referred to the board of administration.

PCCNA OPPORTUNITIES

PCCNA uniquely represents **30 denominations and networks** with **40,000 churches in North America**. We reach underserved church groups, encompass an extant network of relationally connected denominational CEOs, and incorporate a NextGen Cohort of millennial leaders, representing male and female participants from Anglo, African, Asian, and Hispanic cultures. **Our influence is far greater than our size.**

Privileges for board of administration representation from organizations and churches are as follows:

- Six representatives for three million or more members in North America
- Four representatives for one to three million members in North America
- Three representatives for 500,000 to one million members in North America
- Two representatives for 50,000 to 500,000 members in North America
- One representative for 5,000 to 50,000 members in North America
- Parachurch organization in North America may have one representative on the board of administration.
