FLOWER FUND

We have a long tradition of adorning our pulpit with floral arrangements during the High Holidays. We will continue this tradition with your help. Contributions may also be made for other happy occasions, such as B'nai Mitzvah celebrations, weddings, baby namings, get well wishes, etc. Each contribution is \$18. We appeal to you to continue your support which has been so generous during the past years.

ROLL OF REMEMBRANCE

At Anshe Hessed, one of the ways our loved ones live on is by remembering them and by having their name(s) listed in our "Roll of Remembrance" used at the Yizkor service on Yom Kippur afternoon and at the Festivals throughout the year. Any contribution that you should choose to make in connection with this effort will be greatly appreciated and will help us to defray the cost of printing the booklets. If your loved one already has a perpetual memorial, their name is automatically included in the Roll of Remembrance. There will also be a form included in this packet.
