Health and Welfare Policy

The preservation of everyone's health and safety is perhaps Judaism's most important Mitzvah (commandment). Temple Anshe Hesed continues to work closely with and follow the guidance from our COVID Task Force, led by leading doctors and medical professionals, regarding current conditions and guidelines.

As of April 1, 2024, we continue to strongly encourage all congregants and guests attending indoor and outdoor services and events to be up to date with the current COVID vaccinations. These have been shown to protect individuals from COVID (which is still present) as well as reducing severe complications and hospitalizations.

Anyone who is symptomatically ill with ANY respiratory symptoms should not attend services or events and participate via live streaming.

This policy will be reviewed and revised annually or sooner if and when a new COVID variant with more severe effects is identified.
