# **Prayer Books Available**

We realize that there may be reasons why people would prefer to attend one or more services using the YouTube streaming option. Because of this, we will be making prayer books available to borrow again this year. In order to enhance the home worship experience, Temple will offer the option of borrowing a set of High Holiday prayer books.

Prayer book sets will be available to pick up on from Wednesday, September 17 through Friday, September 19 at the Temple office from 9am-3pm. If those times do not work for you, please contact the office at office@TAHerie.org or (814) 454-2426, to make other arrangements prior to those dates. A refundable deposit of \$50 (check or credit card) is due at time of pickup, and you will be required to fill out a Book Loan form at pickup. Prayer books MUST be returned to the Temple office by November 7th, or your check will be cashed/credit card will be charged at that time.

# **High Holy Day Food Drive**
