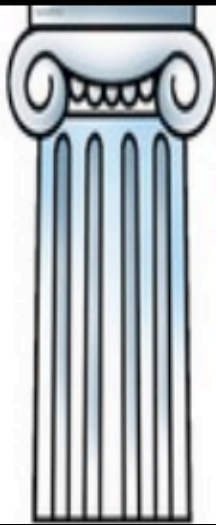
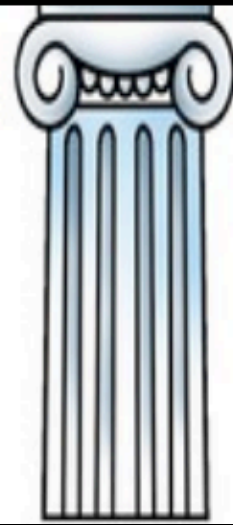


Stop All Fossil Fuel Finance

Racial justice

Chase Bank has a long history of racist practices. Their fossil fuel investing also disproportionately harms communities of color worldwide. Opposing Chase and the other big banks is a vital stand for racial justice.

The UN Secretary General, António Guterres, recently called these banks “financial accomplices” of the fossil fuel industry and said they “must not escape responsibility.”
