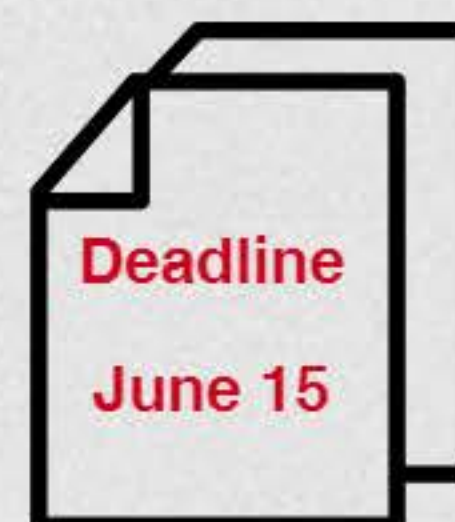


Could this be you?
