St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Lanesborough is celebrating our 250th anniversary this year. As the oldest active parish in the Western Massachusetts Diocese we are honored to have Bishop Douglas Fisher help us celebrate on **Sunday, June 25, 2017 at 10:00 AM.**

This special celebratory service will be held at the Old Stone Church on North Main Street, Route 7 in Lanesborough. All are welcome

In the 1750's a group of families started to worship in the Episcopal faith at the Bradley Farm and formally organized in October, 1767. The Old Stone Church was built in 1836 and in 1862 a hand pumped Johnson organ was added that is still in operation today. The Village Church, a converted house, began services in the 1890's is our winter home. After some years of neglect the Old Stone Church was reactivated in the 1970's with new roof, stone pointing, and interior work and now serves as our summer home.
