

Are you an artist, maker, or creative looking to become a homeowner?

Are you wanting a creative space to call your own? Habitat for Humanity Lafayette and Tippecanoe Arts Federation are working together to make that happen — and applications are open now!

Q: How can I find out if I qualify?

A: Complete our application during an open application period (beginning February 1, 2021). The application period began February 1 and you can pick up an application at 420 S 1st Street OR email Stepheney Bible at stepheney@lafayettehabitat.org.

Q: What do I bring with me to apply?

A: Your completed application packet, your two most recent pay stubs or other verification of income (SSI, SSD statements etc.), and your/any adult in the household's photo ID. We do ask that each individual brings their own ID.

Q: Can I apply online?

A: Not at this time. You can request an application by emailing Stepheney Bible at stepheney@lafayettehabitat.org.

Q: How much will my home cost?

A: Every mortgage Habitat for Humanity of Lafayette provides is unique to each specific homeowner. What we can tell you now is that you/your family's financial situation will be looked at individually and the mortgage payment will be based on what is affordable to you.

Q: How soon can I move in if I am selected?

A: Our Home Ownership program is a long-term commitment. Most families are in their home within 12-18 months of being accepted into the program.

Q: I am on Social Security/Disability, can I still qualify?

A: We consider SSI and SSD income in calculating your yearly gross income. Just because you receive these payments does not disqualify you.

Q: I am not married, but my partner and I want to do this together. Is that ok?

A: YES!

Q: Is Habitat a Christian organization?

A: Yes, Habitat is actually a global nonprofit Christian organization. Everyone who wants to be a part of our work is welcome regardless of religious preference or background. In fact, we welcome and love having individuals and groups of varying backgrounds join us in our work.
