In these days of adaptation and change as we navigate COVID-19, your flexibility is appreciated. This form will help us identify and recruit people to help even while circumstances shift.

Greeter. Greeters arrive early, check in with the Pastor and greet worshippers as they arrive on Sunday morning. Needed: A friendly smile and a warm spirit.

Coffee Host. Hosts prepare coffee in the Commons Café before worship. They oversee things during the fellowship hour following the service. Hosts sometimes bring and share cookies, but it's not required. They remain to clean up afterward.

Usher. Ushers distribute bulletins, pass offering plates (recruiting additional help when needed) and deliver them to the altar, position the communion cup table when communion is at the rail, guide people during communion (as needed), take offering to the safe after the service, collect yellow slips and deliver them to the church office. Training available.

Communion Prep. Preparers come early to set up wafers/bread, wine/juice, cups and altar vestments for distribution of Communion at Sunday morning services. There is an instruction manual in the sacristy. Training available.

Communion Clean up. Cleaners clean up after the morning

services. Chalices, patens, trays, glasses, linens, paraments, and pitchers are returned to the sacristy and cleaned as needed. Training available.

Communion Server. Servers assist the Pastor with communion. They may distribute bread/wafers, distribute juice/wine, or collect empty cups. Those who distribute the elements will speak the words of distribution to each worshiper, and may speak a blessing to those who come forward with hands folded.

Reader. Readers share the scriptures from the altar during the service. Complete scripts are emailed to readers and piled on the front pew before worship. Readers will want to preview and rehearse their assigned readings. Readers for Online worship are asked to video record themselves at home and send it to Taryn Hauglie taryn@oslc-everett.org

Acolyte. Acolytes arrive early and check in with Pastor 10 minutes prior to worship. They light candles, help with Communion and extinguish candles during the closing hymn.
