Did you know?

Locally Volunteers of America provides over 4400 individuals with food monthly. Over 50% of those receiving assistance are children and seniors. Last year 1700 requests were made for holiday meals and they were able to fill all these requests. In 2019 they are anticipating even more. This year over 2100 families are requesting assistance monthly!

We at Our Savior's would like to help our community by providing food baskets and vouchers for at least 100 families at Thanksgiving and at Christmas, as well as a present for each child.

Members have routinely provided food boxes, presents and over \$7500 for fresh food vouchers, helping to brighten the holiday for over 600 people.

After I Sign-up – Then What?


1. Return the “Yes, I want to help!” form to church from September 1 to September 30.
