

## *5 Point Plan for Indoor Worship 9:30am Oct 3*

The Council and Pastors have been working on a way to return to In-person, public In-door worship. The core of that discernment process has been the safety and well-being of EveryOne, especially those most vulnerable.

- Pledge**        Worshippers will pledge that all eligible members of their households have been fully vaccinated and to attest that they have no symptoms on the day we gather.
- Personal**     Face Coverings. EveryOne will be expected to wear while in the building. Yup, even over your nose!
- Pods**         For distancing. We estimate that we have about 6000 square feet of space in the Commons and open Fellowship Hall. There's easily enough room for people to maintain 6 feet of room between household "pods" of worshippers.
- Permission**   We need to be careful with refreshments at the café. You can pull your mask down and take a sip or a bite, but it will need to go up again afterward. Lutherans love to sing! We'll sound just fine, even with face coverings in place.
- Prayers**       We hold one another in our prayers – especially those most vulnerable; children and those yet still unvaccinated. God give us all wisdom, selflessness, patience, and courage as we meet the days ahead
