- 1) Sign up for Alerts in La Habra Heights on your cell phone by texting the message "AlertLHH" to 888777. You will receive notifications regarding road closures, traffic conditions, etc., in La Habra Heights.
- 2) Watch for strangers, strange cars, lock your cars, don't leave valuables in your cars, and be careful answering the door. Ring.com allows you to talk to people at your front door remotely, without being home, and provides video of whoever is at your door.
- 3) Security alarms, security cameras, security signs and dogs are deterrents.
- 4) If you see a stranger or strange car, call the non-emergency line for Industry Sheriff"s: 626.330.3322.
- 5) Scan important documents (& pictures) to the cloud or save them on a flash drive. Back up your computers.
