3 p.m. in the Gym—Avocado Varieties A–Z: Everything You Wanted to Know About Avocados (grafting, planting, varieties and more).



PARKING & ACCESS TO THE PARK

- There's no need to drive to The Park. Park at our Avocado Festival lot at the corner of Hacienda Road and West Road (look for "Parking" signs) and then hop on our Avocado Express Shuttle to the Festival. The parking lot opens at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 4:30 p.m.
- Handicap parking is available in the upper and lower parking lots at The Park.
- Please do not park on the grass or in the Horse Arena this year!
- Because of extensive road repairs, a section of Hacienda Road is closed to traffic coming south from the Hacienda Heights (north) side of the hill. However, The Park (where the Avocado Festival is being held) is fully accessible on Hacienda Road from the south. Just make your way to Whittier Blvd., and then turn north on Hacienda Road, which is open all the way to our parking lot and to The Park (see map at right).
