Bridgeway's Sussex County location provides a range of essential services for adults living with serious mental illness. Programs include Partial Care, a structured day rehabilitation program offering therapeutic, social, educational, and vocational supports that help individuals build skills, pursue goals, and strengthen independence.

The Sussex team also provides Integrated Case Management Services, supporting individuals with recovery planning, community connections, and access to essential resources. PATH Homeless Outreach Services assist individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness with housing navigation, stability, and ongoing support. Supportive Housing provides support and restoration of community living skills. Employment/Career Services are available for those whose work attempts have been interrupted by mental illness and support persons finding and maintaining employment. Outpatient therapy, medication management, and Mobile Crisis Outreach are all part of the services available from our Bridgeway Sussex teams. Together, these programs reflect Bridgeway's commitment to recovery-focused, community-based care that meets people where they are.
