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### WHO IS ELIGIBLE

- ✓ Chronic health conditions: heart disease, cancer, kidney disease, or diabetes
- ✓ Mental health conditions or substance misuse
- ✓ Pregnancy
- ✓ Medical conditions related to an intellectual or developmental disability
- ✓ Frequent emergency room visits or multiple hospital admissions
- ✓ A history of intimate partner violence or domestic violence, or victim of human trafficking
- ✓ A need for assistance with activities of daily living

### HOUSING SUPPORT SERVICES INCLUDE:

- ✓ Pre-Tenancy Services: Assistance identifying, applying for, and obtaining permanent housing.
- ✓ Tenancy Supports: Ongoing assistance maintaining stable housing.
