Founded in 2011 by Stefani Schrimpf and Juan Pablo Trujillo, retired principal dancers of Kansas City Ballet, SCB is the exclusive training center for talented dancers pursuing excellence in dance. Our school director, Juan Trujillo, has received the Outstanding Teacher Award four times (2019, 2020, 2021, 2023) from Youth America Grand Prix, the world's largest global network of dance. In 2024, YAGP awarded SCB the Outstanding School Award.

To provide personalized attention and the highest standard of training available to ensure technical and artistic growth for each student, our class sizes are limited. With smaller class sizes, students reach their optimal potential faster and with precise technique.

Studio Policies

Pre-Professional Academic students in Ballet 2 to Ballet 6 are registering for the academic year (September to May) and will be responsible for the full academic year tuition. Primary students in Creative Movement, Pre-Ballet, Ballet Basics, and Ballet 1 are enrolling in a year-round program (September to August).

All students, new and returning, must pay the \$25 registration fee. Tuition may be paid on an annual (*1 full payment due by the first class*) or monthly (*equal payments due the first class or each month*) basis.

Payments can be made by cash/check, credit card.

Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable, except in the event of a serious illness or injury. Requests for refunds must be accompanied by a doctor's certificate of inability to continue class. Students withdrawing for medical reason may receive credit for future classes.

Placement - *based on age, audition results, and previous experience* - is at the sole discretion of the SCB faculty. Advancement is based on the student's ability to accomplish the elements as established in the SCB syllabus. It is not uncommon for students to remain in the same level for more than one year to complete the syllabus. Should a student's placement change during the school year, any necessary tuition adjustment will be reflected the following month.

Pre-Professional Academic students are strongly advised to attend the SCB Summer Program as the summer programs can provide extra class time to master the syllabus and be considered for promotion in the following academic year.

Students are evaluated up to twice a year. Qualified, unbiased adjudicators evaluate student proficiency according to the list of guidelines and essential skills specified in the SCB syllabus.

For the safety of the student, readiness for pointe shoes will solely be determined by the faculty.

All classes listed for each level is mandatory as is attendance. Students more than 15 minutes late to any class will be asked to sit and observe. Students leaving class early should get permission from the faculty prior to the class. Please do not send your student to class if they have a transmittable illness.

Refunds or pro-rated tuition will not be granted for missed classes. Students can make-up missed classes in the level below with approval from school directors.

Students requesting to withdraw during the school year will be responsible for tuition payments until the end of the enrolled period.

In the event of inclement weather, we follow the Shawnee Mission School District (SMSD) policy. If SMSD is closed or closes early, all classes are cancelled. If SMSD cancels after-school activities, all classes are cancelled. If SMSD has delayed opening in the morning, all classes will continue as scheduled.

For class cancellations due to weather, please check the message on our phone line, email notifications, or our social media outlets.

The primary method of communicating information from the school will be through email. Updates and announcements will also be posted on the bulletin boards or on our Facebook/Instagram page.

Observation weeks for families and friends are held during the year.

- All students – new and returning – must pay a registration fee of \$25 per student due with the first payment.
- Pre-Professional students are registering for the academic year (September to May) and will be responsible for the full academic year tuition. Primary students are enrolling in a year-round program (September to August).
- A 5% full tuition payment discount is available if tuition for the entire year (9 months for Pre-Professional or 12 months for Primary) is paid in September.
- Full year payment is due by the student's first class in September. Monthly payments are due by the student's first class of each month.
- A grace period of 5 days will be honored. Payments received after the 5-day grace period will result in a \$25 late fee regardless of reason.
- Returned checks will be assessed a \$30 service charge plus any related bank fees.
- Students with 2 consecutive months of outstanding tuition will not be allowed in class until their account is paid.
- More general orientation information will be provided after enrollment is complete.
