- Last year was a success with social distancing and safe practices, which will continue this year. Having a safe and healthy market is a major priority for our community.



- **Daily parking rates for non-residents of Town of Skaneateles** - \$20 for trailer & vehicle and \$10 for vehicle. 2022 Seasonal hang passes can be purchased through the Town of Skaneateles website www.townofskaneateles.com "Parks Reservations" - \$200 for vehicle & trailer: \$100 for vehicles.



Just some reminders

- ❖ **Please clean up after your pets at all parks.** The weather has changed and sports, once again, will be in the park and pet waste isn't appreciated. There are plenty of mutt mitts available for use.
- ❖ **No riding bikes on tennis courts, baseball/softball fields.**
- ❖ There may be some closures around the Parks for repairs, please watch for cones and/or vehicles on the path. We try to do the repairs as fast as we can so not to inconvenience anyone, but sometimes it is unavoidable.
- ❖ Driving around the Austin Park Track is **prohibited**. Only service or emergency vehicles are permitted.

Employment Opportunities

Waterfront Lifeguards must possess American Red Cross Waterfront Lifeguarding & CPR/AED Certificates. Looking for mature applicants who can interact with the public. Available from middle of June to Labor Day. Must be available weekends and holidays. **All certifications must be up to date and a copy submitted with application.** All applications must be submitted by May 1st.

Playday Councilors – Monday –Friday - June 27 through August 12. Must be 16 years of age at time of start of program. Must enjoy engaging campers in games and activities. CPR/AED/First Aid training will be provided and will occur prior to start of program. All applications must be in by May 1st.

Parks Laborers - must have valid driver's license, able to perform light and heavy manual tasks, follow directions, self-motivator, and ability to interact with public. May be asked to work some nights and weekends. Applications should be submitted by May 1st.

Preference will be given to Town of Skaneateles residents.

All applications will be subject to a pre-employment substance test and background check.
