The Town recognizes the need to make sure that in the future our Parks and Conservation Areas are providing options for a variety of outdoor activities. This year, Courtney Alexander is the liaison to the Conservation Committee and this group has been recharged to move forward with making sure these beautiful lands are accessible and safe for all to enjoy.

We also know that we had to look at options for Austin Park and Pavilion. This was put on hold as we focused on keeping our departments operational, while protecting our employees while at work and our residents when visiting our offices. Now, with spring around the corner we are ready to look at how we can enhance the Parks, bring new services and activities that our residents have asked us to consider.

There are services at the Town that I want to be sure you are aware of. As you know, all property is assessed by the Town, not all of it is taxable. Some properties, such as those owned by religious organizations or governments are completely exempt from paying property taxes. Others are partially exempt, such as veterans who qualify for an exemption on part of their homes, and homeowners who are eligible for the School Tax Relief (STAR) program. In addition, if you qualify under the criteria, the Town offers exemptions for agriculture, seniors, volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance workers, nonprofit organizations, clergy, disabled persons and commercial and industrial businesses. Applications for exemption must be submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup>.
