Visit the Town Clerk's office to get your hunting and fishing license or process your passport. If looking to apply for your U.S. Passport, please allow for the extending processing times:

Routine: 10-13 weeks
Expedited: 7-9 weeks
Expedited at Agency: Must have international travel withing 72 hours.

May 1st marks the beginning of spring turkey season. Youth hunters, ages 12-15 will have the opportunity to get out April 22nd and April 23rd before the regular season starts.

Getting Married? The Town Clerk's office issues New York State Marriage Licenses. The Clerk's Office at the Town Hall, 24 Jordan Street, Skaneateles, New York 13152 is open Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. -4:00 p.m.



Dog License Survey: New York State Department of Ag & Markets requires all dogs over 4 months of age be licensed with the municipality:

“The owner of every dog 4 months of age or older shall immediately make application for a dog license. Owners apply for this license at the licensing agent in the municipality where the dog is harbored. Contact your municipal clerk to find out what documentation is needed to obtain a license.”

The Skaneateles Town Clerk's office will be conducting a dog survey. All residents in the Town will receive a notice in the mail asking if you have a dog and if the dog is licensed. If your dog is not licensed, we will send you the form or you can visit the Town Clerk's office.
