The Town Clerk's Office will be sending out a dog survey to all residents. All residents will receive a mailing asking if you have a dog and if the dog is licensed.

New York State Agriculture and Markets Law states the following:

"The owner of every dog 4 months of age or older shall immediately make application for a dog license. Owners apply for this license at the licensing agent in the municipality where the dog is harbored. Contact your municipal clerk to find out what documentation is needed to obtain a license."

License fees are set by the municipality per [Article 7, Section 110](#). The municipality may exempt license fees for any guide dog, hearing dog, service dog, war dog, working search dog, detection dog, police work dog, or therapy dog.

All dogs are assigned, as licensed, a municipal identification number and tag."

Proof of a current rabies vaccination is required, and the fees are:

\$7.50 for a spayed/neutered dog

\$20.50 for an unspayed/unneutered dog

And if you are a dog owner that is 65 or older the senior license fees are:

\$2.50 for a spayed/neuter dog

\$15.50 for an unspayed/unneutered dog

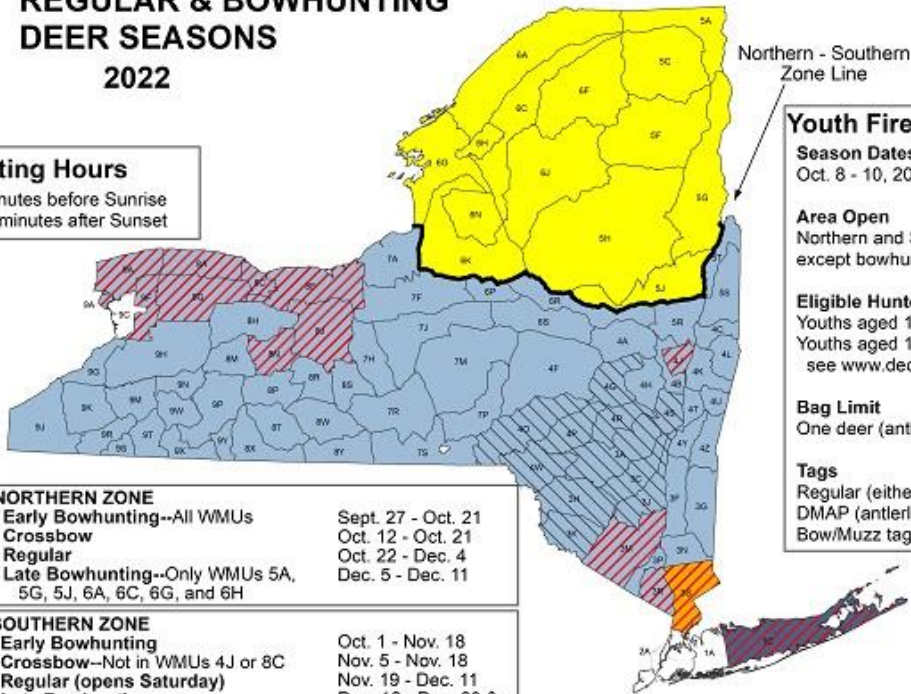

May not be used to hunt deer:

- during the Youth Firearms Season; or
- anytime in WMUs 1C (Suffolk County), 3S (Westchester County), 4J or 8C.

The Thruway Authority is modernizing its 570-mile transportation system by converting to cashless tolling.
