## Ed.D. Program Overview

- ◆ The Ed.D. is designed to prepare students to become executive level educational leaders
- ◆ Students enter the program with a master's or specialist degree in educational leadership or a related field.
- ◆ The program requires students with a masters degree to complete 38 hours of coursework; students with a specialist degree complete 28 hours of coursework.
- ◆ Students complete coursework plus a unique team-oriented doctoral project, a comprehensive examination, and an oral examination.
- ◆ **A large number of graduates from SLUs Ed.D. program are currently serving as Missouri Superintendents**
