SHOES!

Children should wear shoes that will be safe during play. They should wear flat shoes that fit snugly on their feet. The following shoe types are inappropriate: sandals/flip flops, shoes with open toes and Crocs.

- Playing on the playground before and after school is not allowed, even if the parent or caregiver is present.
- Please do not linger in the classroom or extended care area after checking-out your child. If you need to speak with the teacher please do so briefly or schedule a conference time. If you need to speak to other parents please do so outside the classroom.



ClassDojo is a communication app for the classroom. It connects teachers and parents who use it to share photos, videos, and messages through the school day.

Step 1: Create a ClassDojo Account

Download the CLASSDOJO app on your smart phone or create an account online <https://www.classdojo.com/>

Step 2: Ask for your ClassDojo code

Ask your child's teacher for your ClassDojo code (Every child has a unique code) or search for your child's classroom and connect!

Once you create an account (or enter your code into an existing account) you will be able to view posts, read and send messages, and view school stories.



SAFETY FIRST: Walk your child directly to his/her classroom at drop-off time. Do not leave until you are sure the teacher is aware of your child's presence. Dropping your child off at his/her classroom gives you a chance to see your child's classroom, interact with the teacher, meet other parents and say a proper good-bye.
