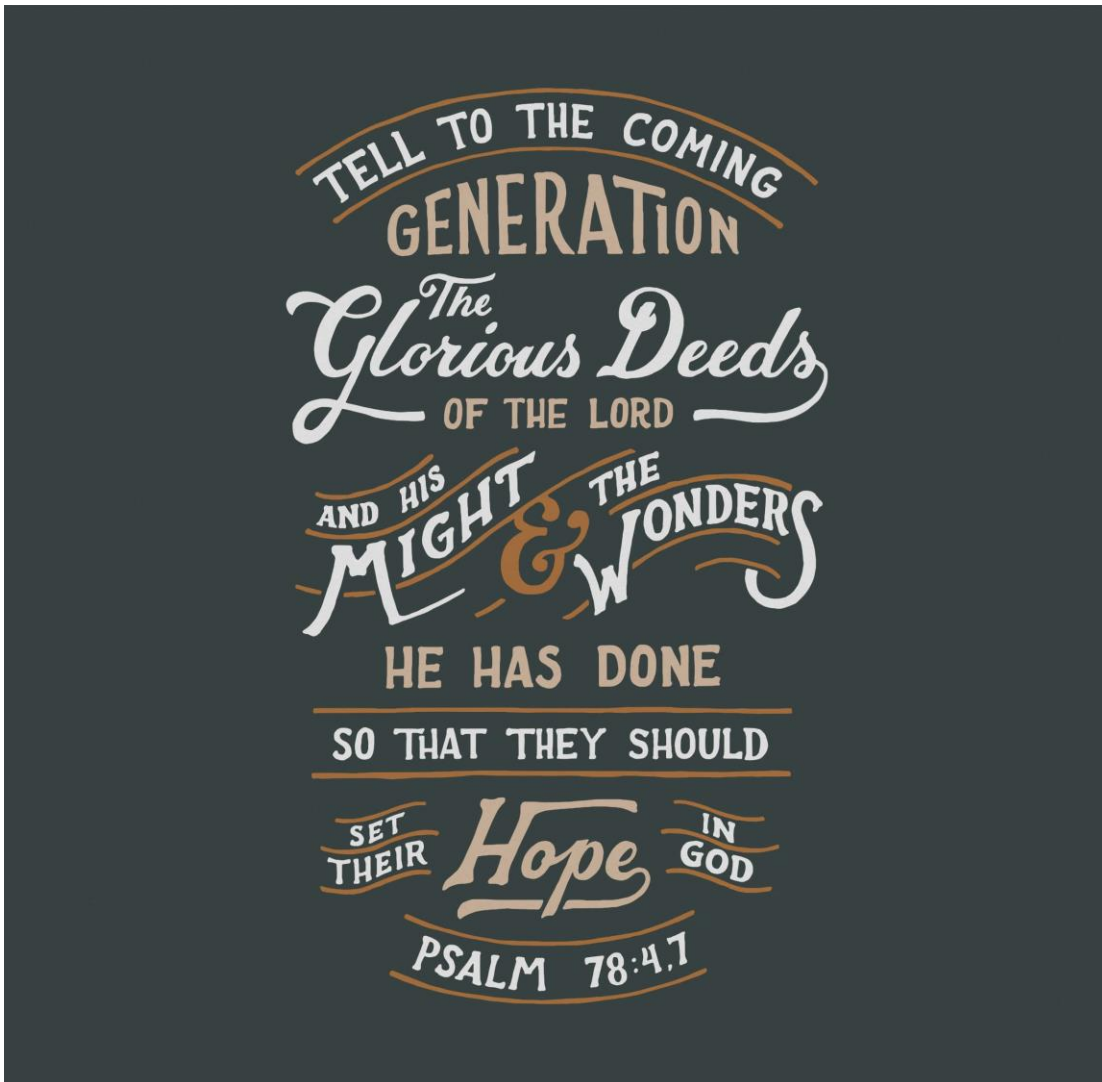

First Reading: Psalm 78:1-8

R: A lesson from Asaph.

- ¹ Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth.
- ² I will open my mouth in parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old,
- ³ things we have heard and known, that our ancestors have told us.
- ⁴ We will not hide them from our children; we will tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might, and the wonders that he has done.
- ⁵ He established a decree in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach to their children;
- ⁶ that the next generation might know them, the children yet born, and raise up and tell them to their children,
- ⁷ so that they should set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but should keep his commandments;
- ⁸ and they should not be like their ancestors, a stubborn and rebellious generation, whose spirit was not faithful to God.
