

Amen.


# Gathering: Come, Beloved of the Maker (ELW # 306 vv. 1,3,5)

# **Baptism of Karen Guzzo**

L: In Baptism our gracious heavenly Father frees us from sin and deaths by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are born children of a fallen humanity; by water and the Holy Spirit we are reborn children of God and made members of the church, the body of Christ. Living with Christ and in the communion of saints, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

Sponsors: I present Karen for baptism

- L: Karen, called by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the grace and love of God, do you desire to be baptized into Christ?
- L: Sponsors, do you promise to nurture Karen in the Christian faith as you are empowered by God's Spirit, and to help her live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the church?

Sponsors: I do

- L: People of God, do you promise to support Karen and pray for her in new life in Christ.
- C: We Do

Assembly to stand as able

- L: Karen, I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.
- L: Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God?

*I renounce them (Karen)* 

L: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God?

I renounce them (Karen)

L: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God?

I renounce them (Karen)

Assembly joins in with Karen

- L: Do you believe in God the Father?
- C: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.
- L: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?
- C: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.
- L: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?
- C: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

- L: The Lord be with you.
- C: And also with you
- L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- C: It is right to give our thanks and praise
- L: Blessed are you, O God, maker and ruler of all things. Your voice thundered over the water at creation. You water the mountains and send springs into the valleys to refresh and satisfy all living things.

Through the waters of the flood, you carried those in the ark to safety.

Through the sea you led your people Israel from slavery to freedom.

In the wilderness you nourished them with water from the rock, and you brought them across the river Jordan to the promised land.

By the baptism of his death and resurrection, your Son Jesus has carried us to safety and freedom. The floods shall not overwhelm us, and the deep shall not swallow us up, for Christ has brought us over to the land of promise. He sends us to make disciples, baptizing in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Pour out your Holy Spirit; wash away sin in this cleansing water; clothe the baptized with Christ; and claim your daughters and sons, no longer slave and free, no longer male and female, but one with all the baptized in Christ Jesus, who lives and reigns with you in unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

L: Karen, I baptize you in the name of the Father And of the Son, And of the Holy Spirit.

You belong to Christ, in whom you have be baptized.

L: Let us pray.

We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give your daughters and sons new birth, and cleanse from sin, and raise them to eternal life.

Sustain Karen with the gift of your Holy Spirit: The spirit of wisdom and understanding, The spirit of counsel and might, The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, The spirit of joy in your presence, Both now and forever.

L: Karen, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit And marked with the cross of Christ forever.
