ClassDojo is a communication app for the classroom. It connects teachers and parents who use it to share photos, videos, and messages through the school day.

Step 1: Create a ClassDojo Account

Download the CLASSDOJO app on your smart phone or create an account online <https://www.classdojo.com/>

Step 2: Ask for your ClassDojo code

Ask your child's teacher for your child's ClassDojo code (Every child has a unique code) or search for your child's classroom and connect!

Once you create an account (or enter your code into an existing account) you will be able read and send messages, and view school stories.

No Shots? No Records? No School.



Children will not be enrolled unless an immunization record is presented and immunizations are up-to-date.*

*If your child is unimmunized due to medical reasons, please notify us.



- **SAFETY FIRST:** Walk your child directly to his/her classroom at drop-off time. Do not leave until you are sure the teacher is aware of your child's presence.
- **SHOES:** Children should wear shoes that will be safe during play. They should wear flat shoes that fit snugly on their feet.
- The following shoe types are inappropriate: sandals/flip flops, shoes with open toes.
- **CHECK-IN / CHECK- OUT:** It is our policy to have every student be checked-in and checked-out by an authorized adult.
- This information is used during our emergency drills to let the teacher know which children are in the class. Please note, NO one under 18 years old can pick up your child.
- **PARKING:** Don't leave children unattended in parked vehicles at any time. Street cleaning is on Wednesday on Doris Avenue. Please notice signs posted by the city.
- **SNACKS:** There are snack calendars located in the classrooms if you wish to sign up to bring a snack for your child's class.
- When sending a snack or packing a lunch for your child to bring to school, please keep this in mind -- **NO PEANUT BUTTER**
- **The only substitute that can be used is Sun butter (sunflower seed butter).** *** Please help us avoid confusion by labeling your child's sandwich "peanut free." ***
