

## **Confession and Forgiveness**

All may make the sign of the cross, the sign that is marked at baptism, as the presiding minister begins.

- L: In the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit
- C: Amen.
- L: God of all mercy and consolation, come to the help of your people, turning us from our sin to live for you alone. Give us the power of your Holy Spirit that we may confess our sin, receive your forgiveness, and grow into the fullness of Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord.

Silence is kept for reflection.

C: We confess that we are captive to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name.

Amen.

L: God, who is rich in mercy, loved us even when we were dead in sin, and made us alive together with Christ. By grace you have been saved. In the name of + Jesus Christ, your sins are forgiven. Almighty God strengthen you with power through the Holy Spirit, that Christ may live in your hearts through faith.

## First Reading: Psalm 90:1-17

A Prayer of Moses, the man of God.

- <sup>1</sup> Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations.
- <sup>2</sup> Before the mountains were brought forth or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.
- You turn us back to dust and say, "Turn back, you mortals."
- For a thousand years in your sight are like yesterday when it is past or like a watch in the night.
- <sup>5</sup> You sweep them away; they are like a dream, like grass that is renewed in the morning;
- in the morning it flourishes and is renewed; in the evening it fades and withers.
- <sup>7</sup> For we are consumed by your anger; by your wrath we are overwhelmed.
- <sup>8</sup> You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your countenance.
- <sup>9</sup> For all our days pass away under your wrath; our years come to an end like a sigh.
- <sup>10</sup> The days of our life are seventy years or perhaps eighty, if we are strong; even then their span is only toil and trouble; they are soon gone, and we fly away.
- Who considers the power of your anger? Your wrath is as great as the fear that is due you.
- <sup>12</sup> So teach us to count our days that we may gain a wise heart.

- <sup>13</sup> Turn, O Lord! How long? Have compassion on your servants!
- Satisfy us in the morning with your steadfast love, so that we may rejoice and be glad all our days.
- <sup>15</sup> Make us glad as many days as you have afflicted us and as many years as we have seen evil.
- Let your work be manifest to your servants and your glorious power to their children.
- Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us and prosper for us the work of our hands-O prosper the work of our hands!
