SDUHSD campuses in Encinitas and Solana Beach use battery-operated leaf blowers to comply with city ordinances that ban gas-powered blowers. Currently, gas-powered blowers are used 10 hours a week, on average, at our campuses within the cities of San Diego and Carlsbad.

During those 10 hours, gas-powered blowers are estimated to emit the hydrocarbon equivalent of driving a Ford F-150 Raptor truck nearly 9,500 miles.
(That's 9,500 miles per week, per campus.)

The TPHS Foundation is sponsoring a district-wide effort to equip ALL SDUHSD campuses with battery-operated leaf blowers. These zero-emission blowers will mean cleaner air and quieter campuses for students, faculty, staff and neighbors.
