These items should be checked periodically

	Main water supply, supplies only your unit
	Green lid box near your entry on the 2,3,4,5 units, near the garage entry on the 1 & 6 units
	Locate it
	Remove lid and check for leaks
	Advise Site Manager if leak observed
-	If the unit is unoccupied for longer than 7 days you must turn this valve off to avoid water intrusion
	The difference of the length that it days you must turn the valve on to avoid water intradicti
	Toilets
	Check flappers for good seal, replace if leaking detected
	Check around base for moisture
	Check supply line for leaks. Replace supply line with braided stainless steel.
-	Make sure fill valves are adjusted properly
-	Check shut off valve for corrosion/leaks
-	
	Check tank gasket and bolts. Replace if rusty or leaking.
	Hot Water Heater
	Check for evidence of leaking at inlet
-	Check for evidence of leaking at time:  Check for evidence of leaking at base

-	Flush annually
-	Check earthquake straps
-	Recommended you turn off the breaker when unit is not occupied
	Consider installing timer to regulate heating and save power
	Sinks (kitchen and bathrooms)
	Check supply lines for leaks
	Replace kitchen sink water filter spigot every 6 months of normal use (Kohler #K-202)
	Clean aerators of calcium buildup that may reduce flow
-	Add 1/4 table spoon cooking oil monthly and spin garbage disposal inlet to inhibit rust
	Mandatory replacement of original Kohler kitchen faucet & water filter supply lines
	Check shut off valve for corrosion/leaks
	Tubs/showers
	Check shower grout for cracks, seal appropriately if any noticed

<b> </b>	Check around shower drain for grout cracks, seal appropriately if noticed
-	Remove, clean and lube tub pop up mechanism if slow drain or difficult to actuate
-	Clean tub aerators of calcium buildup
	Check shower valve leakage from spout
	Dishwasher
-	Run dishwasher periodically to clear filter and lube pump
-	Check shut off valve for corrosion/leaks
	Check hoseds for evidence of moisture
	Check drain line for corrosion/leaks

## Refrigerator Check temp settings for consistency Listen for compressor to cycle on and off, continuous running compressor is not good Replace ice maker supply line with braided stainless steel Check surrounding area for evidence of moisture Page 1 Maintenance Check List continued **Washing Machine** Replace hoses with braided stainless steel Check primary and secondary drains for proper evacuation Air Conditioner Clean primary drain in attic Ensure secondary drain is clear Inspect/Clean/Replace inlet filter located in grate in unit ceiling Inspect/Clean/Replace ac filter within attic assembly Consider installing "wet switch" which shuts off ac in the event of an overflow Check AC plumbing for drips/leaks Windows Check function of all window mechanisms Check function of all slider door mechanisms Anderson window and doors are warranted for 10 years, we are just under that.
