I began taking photos in college and have never stopped. Starting out as a landscape photographer, my interests have expanded to wildlife and people, and I am also drawn to images where nature and man-made elements meet.

A native New Englander, I have photographed all over the region, as well as in our National Parks and Europe. My inspiration today comes primarily from the coastal beauty of Cape Ann, where I have lived for 10 years. Here, I try to capture the uniqueness of each season along with the magic of Cape Ann light, and I particularly enjoy the golden hours of sunrise and sunset. I also seek out secluded places to capture unique scenes, and spend time editing my images to replicate what I saw.

My photographs have been published in *Photographer's Forum Magazine*, *Cape Ann Magazine*, *Cape Ann Guide*, *Lowell Sun* and *Gloucester Times*. I am a juried member of Rockport Art Association, where my work won top awards in 2023 and 2024, and my "Buoys in Snow" photo won the top photography award in the RAA National Exhibit in 2021. I am also a juried member of Cape Ann Artisans. My photographs are on view at Oliver's Restaurant in Gloucester, One Dock Square Gallery in Rockport, the Depot Diner in Beverly, and Cape Ann Coffees in Gloucester.
