The American Legion, Post 3, Gloucester, will again be proudly delivering free **Thanksgiving Holiday Dinners** in 2021 to the elderly, shut-ins, veterans, and needy in the Cape Ann area on Thursday, November 25, 2021. We will be serving Gloucester, Rockport, Manchester, Essex and Ipswich.

Our goal is to serve and deliver as many holiday meals as we can to our fellow veterans, their families and other "special citizens". Last Thanksgiving, even during COVID we served and delivered over 690 Meals Thanksgiving Meals! The demand is still there, if not more, and we intend to honor it.

Due to COVID-19 safety and health concerns ONLY Volunteer Drivers are needed for Thanksgiving Day. Drivers Must Wear Masks when Delivering. Being Fully Vaccinated is a Plus!.

We will need drivers from 10:15am until all of the meals have been delivered. The new procedure will be that drivers WILL REMAIN in their cars outside, be assigned a number, and will not come into the Open Door Food Pantry until called. When their number is called they will pull up to the entrance and their meals will be loaded in their car by other volunteers.
