



LEAP for Education's Summer Internship Program is now recruiting employers and community members!

Be a "Career Mentor" and virtually advise a youth/young adult summer intern in a six-week project-based remote learning experience.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THIS EXCITING PROGRAM:

WHAT DOES THE MENTEE EXPERIENCE LOOK LIKE?

- Mentees will be expected to work remotely 8-12 hours per week on a summer project aligned with their career interests.
- In addition to the project, LEAP will enrich each mentee's experience with summer virtual skill-building workshops. Each Zoom workshop will focus on important workplace skills.
- Mentees will be paid for their participation, provided they finish their project and meet minimum attendance standards.

WHAT IS THE CAREER MENTOR'S TIME COMMITMENT?

- The mentee will meet virtually with their Career Mentor 1-1 weekly for 6 weeks (July 5th - August 13th). This will take about 1 hour per week of your time.
- In the first week, a LEAP staff member and Career Mentor will help the mentee develop a project.
- In weeks two through six, the mentee and mentor will meet virtually on a weekly basis to review project progress and engage in career/job skill exploration.
- LEAP will provide our Career Mentors with weekly discussion plans to cover a variety of job readiness topics.

WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF REMOTE PROJECTS?

- Social media help for your business
- Research projects
- Community Service
- Telemarketing
- Music, art, photography, dance, journaling
- Create educational videos
- Data Entry
- Certifications such as ServSafe or CompTIA IT

WHO ARE THE MENTEES, AND HOW ARE THEY BEING RECRUITED AND MATCHED?

- The program is free and open to all local youth and young adults age 14+, however, we are targeting participants from underserved populations such as those that may be first-generation-to-college, or economically disadvantaged.
- LEAP is currently recruiting and interviewing youth and young adults to prepare them to interview with you virtually or by phone before finalizing a mentor relationship to make sure of a good fit.
