Job Description: Summer Tour Coordinator Internship

The Gloucester Adventure, Inc. ("Schooner Adventure" or "Adventure") is a 501(c)(3) maritime historic preservation and educational organization. We are the stewards of the 1926 dory-fishing Schooner Adventure, a National Historic Landmark. Our mission focuses on preserving the vessel, and using her for educational and community experiences on the water and dockside.

This summer we will offer public deck tours of our historic schooner four days a week, Mon., Tues., Fri., Sat., 10am-4pm. A team of our volunteer docents (tour guides) will be on the pier and on the vessel to greet visitors and answer questions. The Tour Coordinator Intern will:

- Learn enough about the history and workings of the schooner to give a public tour;
- Work with members of our staff to design tour docent trainings;
- Lead training tours (with our experienced expert docents);
- Schedule docent shifts;

During the sailing season the intern will spend most of their time on the vessel:

- Leading tours;
- Interfacing with the public about the vessel and the organization;
- Managing the overall flow of deck tour program.;
- Other activities may include assisting year-round staff with marketing, merchandise sales, data collection, and development (fundraising).

Applicants

This is a part-time summer position, with an average of 18 hours per week. The position runs from early June – August 31. Starting date and some hours are flexible, but applicants **must be available to work Mondays and Tuesdays starting July 1.**

Pay is \$17.50/hr All staff are invited to bring guests to sail on Adventure with them; free tickets will be provided.
