1. What city do you live in?
2. How old are you?
3. Are you married?
4. Does anyone claim you on their taxes?
5. Do you claim anyone on your taxes? Any dependents?
6. What is the gross income in your household?
7. Is any income in the household, self-employment?
8. What is your immigration status? (US citizen, resident, under visa, etc.)
9. Is anyone in the household pregnant?

Items to bring to your appointment

1. Identification of California
2. Taxes (most recent)
3. Social Security Card (If Resident, Citizen, or born in US)
4. Proof of Current Address (Utility Bill or Gas Bill)
5. Residency Card or Citizenship Certificate (If not born in the United States)
6. Current paycheck stubs (the last 2 within 45 days)
7. Birth Certificate (If born in the U.S)
8. Bank Statement (A copy of last month statement) ***only for 65+**
9. Rental Agreement or Rent Receipt and Bills: water, gas, electricity, phone

****If you are married, you are required to bring all the specified document list for spouse, although she/he may not be applying.**

****If you have minor children and you report them in your taxes as dependents, you will need to bring all the specified documents listed.**

****If you are only applying for yourself, you are still required to bring all the required list of documents for all the individuals listed in your tax return.**

****If pregnant, you need to bring proof of pregnancy**
