Re: Allegations of election law violations

Dear Senator Chase,

In a recent interview about the ongoing elections you stated: "I know how Democrats are cheating, and that information has been given to the Youngkin campaign."¹

Under the Voting Rights Act of Virginia², the Attorney General may initiate a civil enforcement action to protect the rights of voters "whenever the Attorney General has reasonable cause to believe that a violation of an election law has occurred and that the rights of any voter or group of voters have been affected by such violation..."

Therefore, if you have evidence of ongoing election fraud, cheating, or misconduct, please contact me as soon as possible so we may make arrangements to receive and review it. I can be reached by email at STowell@oag.state.va.us.
