**ORDER**


On July 23, 2020, the parties appeared, represented by Counsel, on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Temporary Injunction Relief. After hearing the argument of the parties, the Court took the matter under advisement. Having considered the filings, the argument of the parties, and the relevant law, the Court **GRANTS** Plaintiffs’ Motion. Therefore, for all of the reasons set forth in this Court’s Letter Opinion of August 3, 2020, which is incorporated herein by reference, the Defendants and their agents and assigns are hereby **ENJOINED** from removing, altering, or dismantling, in any way, the Robert E. Lee Monument and Pedestal from its current location on Monument Avenue in the City of Richmond. The injunction shall remain in effect for ninety days or for such period as may be set by further Order of this Court.

Pursuant to Rule 1:13 of the Supreme Court of Virginia, the Court dispenses with the parties’ endorsement of this Order. The Defendants’ objections to this Court’s ruling, as stated in their filings and on the record, are noted.

The Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the parties.
