Certificates of Need: Revises & deletes certain provisions relating to local health councils, rural hospitals, health facility licensing, & certificates of need; provides duties of AHCA & DOH.

Emergency Services for an Unintentional Drug Overdose: Requires hospital providing emergency services to person suffering from unintentional drug overdose to provide certain services & information; provides conditions for patient transfer to licensed detoxification or addictions receiving facility; provides attending physician responsibilities; provides conditions under which person who suffers unintentional drug overdose & seeks emergency services & care may not be charged, prosecuted, or penalized for specified offenses.
