

July 2019 updates to prior authorizations and post service claim edits

Security Health Plan requires prior authorization (PA) or post service claim edits (PSCE) for certain medications in order to ensure coverage and payment for those services. A number of requirements have been added for 2019 as we work to make sure all care, services and treatments are medically necessary.

SHP will implement additional PA's July 1, 2019 which include:

Specialty drug infusions in office-based and outpatient settings

- Somatuline Depot® (lanreotide)

SHP will implement additional PSCE's beginning July 1, 2019 which include:

Specialty drug infusions in office-based and outpatient settings

- Revcovi® (elapegademase-lvlr)
- Gamifant® (emapalumab-lzsg)
