## July 2021 updates to prior authorizations and post service claim edits

Security Health Plan requires prior authorization (PA) and post service claim edits (PSCE) on certain medications in order to ensure coverage and payment for those services. A number of requirements have been added for 2021 as we work to make sure all care, services and treatments are medically necessary.

## Security Health Plan will implement additional PAs & PSCEs July 1, 2021, which include:

- Breyanzi<sup>®</sup> (lisocabtagene maraleucel)
- Abecma<sup>®</sup> (Idecabtagene Vicleucel)
