

Reminder regarding claim edits to enhance claim edit efficiency

Security Health Plan has payment policies that reflect guidelines set forth by industry standards. Our goal is to process claims consistently and in accordance with best practice standards.

As communicated in our May 2023 Provider Newsletter, Security Health Plan has implemented additional enhancements to our claims editing programs that promote correct coding and billing practices. Security Health Plan utilizes industry standard claim editing software including Optum Claims Edit System (CES) for primary editing and Cotiviti as a second pass editing vendor. Security Health Plan believes that this will enable you and your billing staff to more readily understand our payment/denial of claims given the widespread use of these policies. You may receive claims denials or payment changes based on these enhanced claim editing concepts on your Explanation of Benefits or electronic remittances.
