How to Participate

Submit your student's name and total number of minutes on our <u>Google Form.</u>

Once all minutes have been submitted and counted, prizes will be awarded to the top three readers of both elementary and middle school. We'll also see if we meet Executive Director Frau Christensen's school challenge!

Lesemarathon Prizes

Individual prizes are awarded to the top three students of both elementary and middle school, based on the total minutes a student has read.





Lesemarathon Rules

- Individual prizes are awarded based on the total minutes a student has read.
- In-class reading minutes can be counted.
- > Students may read printed or digital materials.
- Friends and family may read aloud to the student.
- Audio books (that don't have a book to follow along with) **do** count, as long as it is active listening (as opposed to background noise).

Psssst...did you know we have audiobook CDs in our school library students may check out!?

All reading minutes need to be submitted by the evening of March 20.

Suggested Reading Times:

- Kindergarten: 15-20 minutes per day
- Grades 1-4: 20-30 minutes per day
- Grades 5-8: 30-60 minutes per day

If every TCGIS student reads the minimum amount of minutes listed above as per their grade, we will reach a combined total of approx. 168,350 minutes.

If every TCGIS student reads the maximum amount of minutes as listed above as per their grade, we will reach a combined total of approx. 297,360 minutes.



Do I need to read in German for my minutes to count?

While we encourage our students to read in German (especially our older students), any language counts!
