The journey I have embarked on has not always been so easy, but the more I stay in recovery the more I see the fruit bearing. The more I see the grace of God and the healing that can take place when we truly "bear one another's burdens" and allow other to bear our burdens. God is faithful and He gets all of the glory for the healing that is taking place, but there is something to be said about being in community. And the word testifies to the importance of fellowship.
