


The following memorandum, prepared on behalf of Woody Thrasher for Governor, details the research findings from a study conducted by WPA Intelligence among Republican primary voters in West Virginia. The survey was fielded December 16-December 18, 2019, gathering insights n=502 likely Republican primary voters. The margin of error in the study is ±4.4%.

Candidate Images

In just this last year, two different stories are emerging: Governor Justice's favorables have decreased and Woody Thrasher's name identification has skyrocketed with his favorables following this same trend.

- Woody Thrasher's name identification has increased 39-points since March and his favorable have increased 21-points.
- Governor Justice, on-the-other-hand, remains well-known but his favorables have decreased eight-points. At this same time, Justice's unfavorables have increased six-points.







Ballot


The Republican primary for West Virginia Governor nomination is now a dead heat.

- As voters have learned more about both Thrasher and Governor Justice, the ballot has tightened.
- Thrasher has increased on the ballot 25-points since March to 30%.
- Governor Justice has decreased on the ballot 20-points since March to 38%.



- Republican primary voters who have heard of both Woody Thrasher and Governor Justice are split between the two.
- Thrasher leads Governor Justice by twenty-one points among Republican primary voters who have opinions on both candidates.






Justice Re-Elect

While Justice was in trouble back in March with a hard re-elect of 32%, Republican primary voters are even less likely to re-elect him now (28%).

There has been a five-point increase in voters who would vote to replace Justice.



Research Design

WPAi selected a random sample of registered voters from the West Virginia voter file using Probability Proportionate to Size sampling (PPS). The sample for this survey was stratified based on geography, age, and gender. This methodology allows us to avoid post-survey "weighting" which can reduce the reliability of survey results. Respondents were contacted by phone via a live telephone operator interview December 16-December 18, 2019. The study has a sample size of n=502 Republican primary voters (37% cell phones) with a margin of error of ±4.4%.
