

THE GUIDELINES FOR DONATIONS

1. There will be large plastic tubs placed on the right side of the back door for donations. One will be marked for glass and canned goods, while the other tub will be for paper products and boxed items. The tubs will be outside the church office each day from 10AM until 6PM starting this Saturday, March 28th.
2. When you bring the donations, please put the items in the plastic tub on an individual basis. Please do not put them in the tub in plastic bags, paper bags or boxes.
3. Please make sure that the top is firmly back on the plastic tub once you have placed your items inside of it.
4. We are strongly encouraging that you either use plastic gloves when putting the donations in the plastic tub, or immediately use hand sanitizer before and after the donation process.
5. Also, if there are other people dropping off donations at the same time that you might be making your own donation, please continue to use social distancing practices.
6. There will be a person assigned each day to move the collections inside of the church. We will also have assigned team members who will take the donations to Roxbury Social Services at least once a week, depending on the level of donations. These are church volunteers who will be following the guidelines for sanitation as defined by our GNJ UMC conference.
7. The process for giving the donations to Roxbury food bank from our church will be defined by the Roxbury Board of Health based on all current state guidelines.
