

Urban Infrastructure Trade Mission to India, February 10-14 - Municipalika 2020

The Ontario Ministry of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade invites Ontario companies to participate in an **Urban Infrastructure Trade Mission to India** from **February 10-14, 2020.**

The trade mission will consist of B2B meetings, site visits/corporate calls, a three-day conference and networking opportunities in Mumbai and Bangalore, followed by participation at Municipalika 2020 (<u>https://municipalika.com/</u>), scheduled to take place in Bangalore from February 12-14. Delegates will have their own kiosk in the Ontario/Canada pavilion and meet with Indian business contacts.

The Indian Market

- India is one of the fastest growing economies in the world and boasts five megacities, each with a population of at least 10 million people.
- The Indian government will invest heavily in the infrastructure sector, including highways, railways, ports, airports, renewable energy, smart cities, and transportation to meet the challenges associated with significant urban growth.
- In its 2019-20 budget, India announced it will boost the infrastructure sector by allocating US\$63.2 billion.
- India plans to develop 100 smart cities.
- Municipalika 2018 included 14 participating Canadian companies, with several delegates forging partnerships and pursuing key opportunities. The 2020 trade show will host 2,000 attendees, international country pavilions, state pavilions, and municipal corporations, in addition to 12,000+ urban professionals and 170+ solution providers exhibiting their technologies.

Ontario companies will meet major stakeholders including:

- Municipal corporations
- Infrastructure and construction companies
- Industry-specific distributors
