
TUESDAYS

Old Testament Survey, Pt 2 - FS104 - (Tuesday, May 18 – Tuesday, July 13)
Facilitator: Deacon Howard Hill

This 10-week course presents a study of the last 22 books of the Old Testament. These chronologically parallel the historical books, presenting the heart expressions of the Israelites through their poetry and the messages of their prophets. The information is presented in outline form and provides theological significance for each book.

How to Have Financial Peace – LA412 - (Tuesday, May 18 – Tuesday, June 8)
Facilitator: Deacon Joseph Parker

During this four-week study, the students will grasp God's plan for their finances, acknowledge their current level of stewardship, and chart out the steps needed to handle money in a way that honors God. The students will leave with a better understanding of biblical facts about honoring God with our finances and a detailed step-by-step plan for attaining financial excellence.



THURSDAYS

Peacemakers, Part 1 – LA316 - (Thursday, May 20 – Thursday, June 24)

Facilitator: Dr. Buce Tahalele

In Matthew 5:9 Jesus declares, "Blessed are the peacemakers." But it often seems like conflict and disagreement are unavoidable. Serious, divisive conflict is everywhere-within families, in the church, and out in the world. It can seem impossible to overcome its negative force in our lives. Using the book *Peacemaker* by Ken Sande, during this 6-week session, the students will be presented with biblically based comprehensive and practical theology for conflict resolution designed to bring about not only a cease-fire but also unity and harmony. Exploring godly wisdom and useful plans, the students go beyond resolving conflicts to true, life-changing reconciliation with family members, coworkers, and fellow believers. The students' confidence will be strengthened as they learn the importance of being agents of God's grace as peacemakers.

Prayer: The Ultimate Conversation - LA314 - (Thursday, May 20– Thursday, July 1)

Facilitator: Brother George Cooper

This six-week course is designed to provide instruction on the disciplines of intercession and explain how to fight life's battles through intimate communion with the Lord. Using the book, *Prayer, The Ultimate Conversation*, students will learn how to truly know God through communicating with Him. Topics for discussion include learning to recognize the sound of the Father's voice, recognizing how your perception of God shapes your prayer life, winning your battles through prayer, and finding true peace and joy through intimacy with the Lord. Through this course, the student will learn more about the discipline of prayer and, through practical application, gain a greater understanding of knowing God through communication with Him.

God Is It You I'm Hearing? – LA318- (Thursday, May 20– Thursday, July 8)

Facilitator: Sister Sonetra Howard

This eight-week study allows the students to discover the root to clear and daily communication with God - humble obedience. Learning how to surrender unlocks His many blessings intended for us, centers us in His will, and helps us discern His voice in everyday life.
