

Construction Continues at the Oakridge Estate Park

The end of 2018 will mark the completion of the 8.5 acre passive recreation park adjacent to the historic Oakridge Estate at 18650 Devonshire Street in Northridge. The new park entrance to the Oakridge Estate Park will be located on Devonshire near the Wilbur Wash and across from the Little League Fields.

This unique park, with logs and rocks for imaginative play, will include an adventure area with horses for climbing and a bouncy tractor. A meandering looped walking path, picnic areas and a gathering/classroom space have been created. The site has a number of mature trees and nearly 150 trees newly planted trees that will provide shady recreational spaces near a large open meadow. The images on page one of the newsletter give you a feel for what to expect when you visit the park. The aerial drone images were again provided by a volunteer photographer, Shel Mosk. Shel's skills and equipment have provided a bird's eye view to us throughout the construction process that began in November 2017.

This new public park will be managed and maintained by the LA City Recreation and Parks Department. Prop K funds were used to construct the first phase. So, get your walking shoes ready to hit the trail at the Oakridge Estate Park in 2019. Why not pack a picnic lunch?
