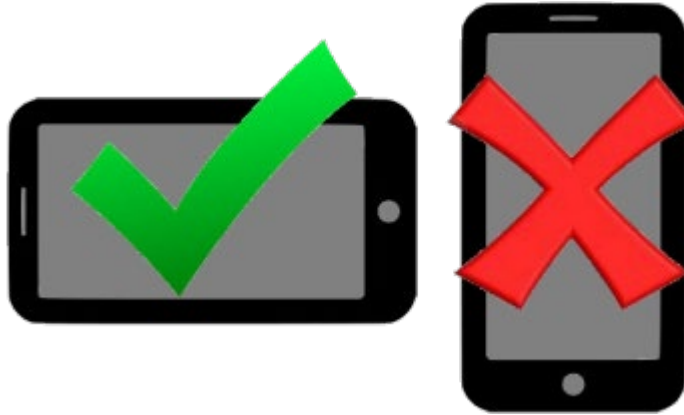
Step 1: Prepare Your Equipment

If you already have a video camera that can shoot 4k (or 1080p), you're set!

Resolution: Yes, you can use your smartphone! Video resolution at 4k is preferred, but we can accept 1080p.

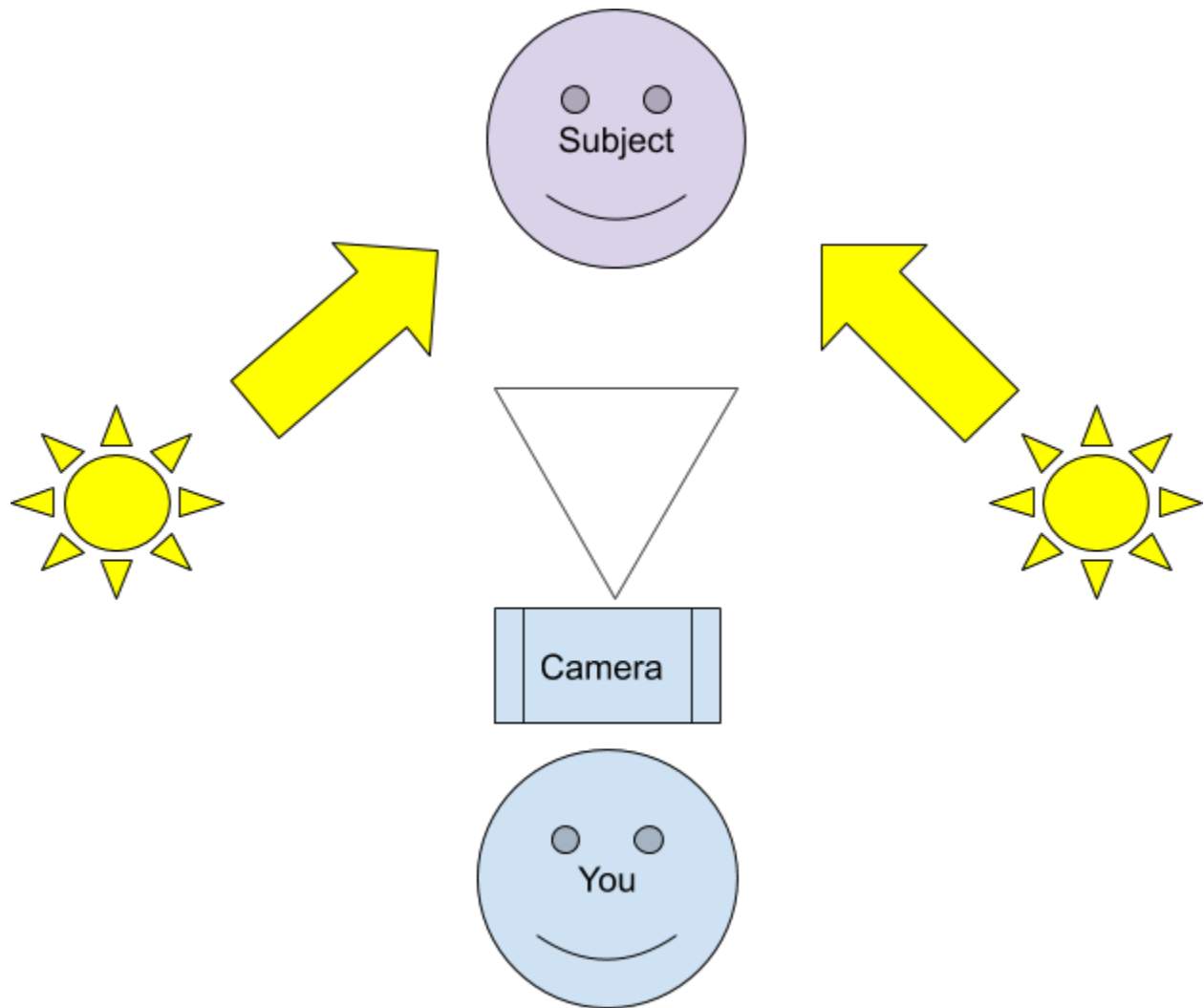

Orientation: Remember to shoot your video in landscape mode, NOT portrait!



Step 2: Prepare Your Environment

Lighting: Make sure the subject is well lit from the front.



Quiet on Set! Be sure you're in a quiet environment. We don't want your District video filled with people talking or traffic noises in the background.

Step 3: Shoot

Length: Keep it less than 2.5 minutes per subject. Less is more when it comes to online videos!
