- Practice Fee Paid (only applies to practice option 2)

### MBS Middle School Swimming Season Information

### **Practice & Skills Requirements:**

To participate in Middle School Swim Meets students must meet the following practice & skills requirements:

- Practice: able to attend 2-4 practices per week during the middle school swim season under one of the
  three options outlined in the Practice Options document. Practice days and times depend upon which
  practice option is chosen and will vary by student. Please review the <u>MBS Middle School Swimming</u>
  Practice Options document for detailed information.
- Skills: able to swim 50 yards of freestyle and 25 yards of backstroke unattended\*

\*Crawfish Aquatics offers training group options for swimmers that do not meet the skill level requirement. Their Novice program offers a skills-appropriate starting place for those who want to participate on their school swim team once they can execute these skills. If interested, please ask our MBS Team Parent Representative for more information.

### 2018 Middle School Swim Season:

The middle school swim season begins with practice starting August 22<sup>nd</sup>, approximately two weeks prior to the first meet and the season runs for eight weeks. The Middle School Swim Season consists of seven meets but only <u>four per school team</u>. Participating school teams are divided into three groups: Cluster 1, 2 and 3. The 2018 cluster group assignments are listed below. MBS will be in Cluster 3.

### **Meet Format**

The Kick-Off meet for all cluster groups will feature the 4 x 50 of each stroke, followed by two meets for each of the two cluster groups which will include relay events. For the first cluster group meet, the 200 Free Relay will be offered and for the second cluster group meet, the 200 Medley Relay will be offered (both relays will be offered at the Championship Meet). The Kick-Off and Cluster Meets will not be scored. Swimmers will be ranked under one single grade division for these meets.

The Championship meet will host all teams and will be the only scored meet. There will be awards for team champion, first through third; and for individuals, first through eighth. For the championship meet, individual events will be ranked/scored by two grade divisions: 5th/6th grade and 7th/8th grade.

### **Meet Guidelines**

- 1. Current USA Swimming technical rules and code of regulations will be used for judging (all meets) and scoring (championship meet).
- 2. All events will be timed finals seeded slowest to fastest.
- 3. Each swimmer may compete in 2 events at the Kick Off meet, 3 events per regular season meets (maximum of 2 individual events) and 4 events in the Championship meet (maximum of 2 individual events).
- 4. There is no limit on individual entries per event per team (for all meets in the season)
- 5. Relay limits: Each team may enter 2 relays (A,B) per event for cluster meets and 1 relay (A) for the Championship Meet.

### MBS Middle School Swimming

### **Practice Options**

- 1. Practice Option 1: Current Year-Round Members of (a) Crawfish Aquatics or (b) Tiger Aquatics This option is only for students who are currently enrolled and paying dues to CRAW or TAQ as year-round members. This option is not school sponsored. The student attends his/her regular practices at their respective club.
- 2. Practice Option 2: Crawfish Aquatics Middle School Practice Groups

- Crawfish Aquatics offers middle school practice groups exclusively to students whose schools are members of the Middle School Swim League. Swimmers must be able to swim 50 yards of freestyle and 25 yards of backstroke without assistance to participate in the Middle School practice groups; however, Crawfish Aquatics does offer other training programs if the swimmer does not meet the Middle School practice group skill requirements. Contact our MBS Coach Kyle Batson for more information. The Crawfish Aquatics Middle School practice groups are designed to improve skills and build confidence by grouping middle school swim league team members according to their ability and not necessarily by school. The MBS time slot will be assigned soon but it will either be 5:30-6:30 or 6:30-7:30 Monday through Thursday. Students can opt to practice 2-4 times per week. Practices begin Wednesday, August 22 and continue through Friday, October 19 (no practice on Labor Day). The Middle School Practice Group option is school sponsored. Practices are conducted by Certified Crawfish Aquatics Coaches and moderated by the MBS Team Parent Representative. Cost to participate is \$115.00 for the season and will be additional.
- 3. Practice Option 3: Crawfish Aquatics or Tiger Aquatics 2018 Fall Seasonal Swim Team Enrollment A student may join the Crawfish or Tiger Aquatics swim team as a seasonal member. With seasonal swim team enrollment, the student becomes a member of the CRAW or TAQ swim team. In addition to participation in middle school meets, CRAW or TAQ membership allows students the opportunity for further participation in USA Swimming sanctioned and non-sanctioned swim meets. This option is not school sponsored. Under this option, parents register and pay CRAW or TAQ directly. The student attends his/her regular practices at their respective club.
