



ASA Compliance Numbers are issued directly to ASA member companies that meet the following requirements:

1. Be a current ASA member in good standing
2. Purchase and abide by the ASA Standard Sign Details Manual
3. Sign the ASA Waiver of Liability
4. Purchase ASA Compliance Numbers

These steps ensure that our members understand the standards, responsibilities, and safety requirements involved when applying for permits through municipalities such as the City of Edmonton.

When a permit application is submitted using an ASA Compliance Number, the City sends an automated verification request to the ASA. No permit using a Compliance Number is approved until the ASA verifies that the company is eligible.

This verification protects the integrity of the program and ensures Compliance Numbers remain an exclusive member benefit.

We understand that some members use outside companies to help prepare and submit permits. ASA supports this, provided the third-party company follows its guidelines.

To clarify:

ASA Associate Members who specialize in permits ARE allowed to submit applications using ASA Compliance Numbers on your behalf.

These companies are members of the ASA and understand the requirements and responsibilities of our Compliance Number Program.

What does this mean for you? If your company uses a third-party permit provider, you may continue to use ASA Associate Members who provide permit services; these companies are eligible and follow program guidelines.

The ASA Compliance Number Program exists to support our members, uphold industry standards, and maintain professional accountability with municipalities. Protecting the integrity of this program ensures that it remains a reliable and valuable benefit for all ASA members.
